The city is located approximately 200 km from Warsaw, the capital city, and 300 km from Cracow. It is easily accessible from all directions thanks to the airport and a network of modern roads.

With its rich history and dynamic academic community, Lublin hosts young and active people within its 70,000-strong student fraternity, including over 8,000 foreign students. In the scale of the whole Lublin region, 80% of all students gain their knowledge and experience in the city of Lublin.

Among numerous reasons why students choose Lublin as their academic centre, the comfort of life and high educational standards deem to be the most significant ones. Lublin's universities are constantly updating their infrastructure, educational offer, research facilities and they strongly support students' scientific and non-scientific activity.

ACCOMMODATION

Students may be accommodated in the Students' Residence Halls at the University Campus area. The condition of acceptance for accommodation is filling an application while registering for studies in the electronic recruitment system.

The number of places in the Hall of Residence is limited and the application does not mean the automatic reservation of accommodation.

- Rooms are equipped with beds, desks, desk lamps, wardrobes, kitchen annex, bedding, bed lining.
- One kitchen and shared bathroom per floor are at students' disposal.
- Each room has Internet connection.
- Room service is not provided.


- Take your original documents and visit Office of International Education








Application

The application process is online!



QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS [WHEN YOU APPLY]:

- higher education diploma with legalization (or apostille) and annotation
- official transcript of records/diploma supplement with scale of grades included confirmed by the University
- passport page with your photo and personal data
- official certificate confirming your command of the language of instruction (see below)



CANDIDATES MUST PROVE THEIR ENGLISH LANGUAGE KNOWLEDGE BY PRESENTING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

A document proving the fact that first cycle studies have been conducted in English

OR

One of the recognized B2 certificates:

- TOEIC at least 700 points
- IELTS over 6 points
- TOEFL iBT at least 87 points
- TOEFL CBT at least 180 points with additional at least 50 points from Test of Spoken English (TSE)
- TOEFL PBT at least 510 points with additional at least 3.5 points from Test of Written English (TWE) and at least 50 points from Test of Spoken English (TSE)
- First Certificate in English (FCE), Certificate in Advanced English (CAE), Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE), Business English Certificate (BEC) Vantage — at least Pass

ENROLLMENT DOCUMENTS[WHEN YOU ARE ACCEPTED]:

- personal questionnaire
- first cycle diploma with legalization (or apostille) and its sworn translation into Polish
- diploma supplement (transcript of records) together with curricula content and their sworn translation into Polish
- grade scale (if not specified in education documents) issued by the University and its sworn translation into Polish
- certificate of English language
- medical certificate stating no contraindications to undertake education in a chosen field of study (a referral is issued after arrival to Poland)
- a disease and accident insurance policy covering the period of education in Poland, or the European Health Insurance Card
- two photos (size 35 mm x 45 mm)
- a copy of valid passport with visa page
- a certificate of recognition (nostrification) of higher education diploma (if applicable)
- original Power of Attorney, authorizing a person to act on behalf of the Student (if necessary)

- For qualification purposes, the documents (transcript/supplement, diploma, grading scale) must be translated into English.
- During the registration at LUT, you must submit their sworn translations into Polish



INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

MSc (magister)

Length of study: 4 semesters / 2 academic years

Programme description

The Innovation and Entrepreneurship students will be able to learn about modern management in many aspects including: strategic management, macroeconomics, finance and accounting, human resources management, production planning, legal issues of running business, ethics in business, marketing, advertising, quantitative methods, applications of IT in business.

Our teaching staff consists of specialists in multiple fields of management science as well as of law, computer science and applied mathematics. Many lecturers have also practical experience in business and consulting.

Career prospects

The specialty is intended to educate managers-to-be who can successfully face the challenges of the rapidly changing world including globalization processes as well as the impact of modern IT technologies. The educational process is not restricted to teach the graduates to act in the economically efficient way only. The overall approach to management education also includes the issues of social responsibility, ethics and sustainable development.

Key issues and competences

The graduate acquires a thorough knowledge in the field of economic, business and social processes, functioning of organization, team leadership as well as social communications and negotiations. The graduate is provided with skills of diagnosing and solving management problems.

SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT AND WEB SERVICES

MSc (magister)

Length of study: 3 semesters / 1.5 academic year

Programme description

The Software Development and Web Services students have the opportunity to familiarize themselves with three most popular mobile platforms: Android, Microsoft Windows and iOS. The studies curricula focuses on such subjects as: mobile databases, applications programming for three mentioned above platforms, designing applications and modelling them, software projects management, gathering information from mobile devices sensors, GIS and GPS usage and many other. All students will be given wide knowledge from the most important aspects of creating IT systems for mobile devices.

Career prospects

This study educates highly-qualified specialists, familiar with present standards and technologies used in mobile applications development. The graduates enter the European market and find jobs in the branch of IT as programmers, testers, analysts, project managers and many other positions correlated with software development.

Key issues and competences

The araduates:

- possess broad knowledge and skills necessary to create software for such mobile platforms as: Android, Microsoft Windows and iOS
- are able to be a member of developers teams
- are able to manage IT projects
- are able to design IT systems with mobile solutions
- understand application projects created in UML
- have skills to gather data from various sensors, process it and use
- can design and create databases for mobile devices
- know how to use GIS and GPS in IT solutions.

Extra requirement: First degree diploma in the field of Computer Science.




